Furniture Workplace case study

Swansea Council

We worked with Swansea Council to update the Civic Centre workspaces.

A design and furniture installation project using remanufactured furniture. Swansea Council needed to update their workplace offices and staff areas but were very keen to reduce their impact on the environment by recycling as much old furniture as possible.

The offices were refurbished with G64R remanufactured chairs, reengineered desking and lockable storage made from old desks.

The staff dining area contained dining tables and poseur tables remanufactured from scaffolding planks and poles. Privacy pods and soft seating chairs and sofas introduced a space for relaxing during breaks. Poseur tables and high chairs provided a suitable area for
